with a preface by dr zak cope as lauesen details we today live in a world of massive and unprecedented inequality never before has humanity been so starkly divided between the haves and the have nots never before has the global situation been accelerating so quickly the third world national liberation movements of the 20th century very much triggered the liberatory movements that did manage to emerge in the first world and seemed for an all too brief moment to point to an escape hatch from history's downward spiral but for many today that all seems like ancient history the global perspective bridges the gap between third worldist theory and the question of what is to be done in a first world context it is an important contribution towards developing an effective political practice based on the realities of the global situation avoiding the pitfalls of sugarcoating the situation with the first world populations or of falling into pessimistic quietism it bridges the gap not only between generations but also between theory and practice as lauesen says it is a book written by an activist for activists global capitalism is heading into a deep structural crisis in the coming decades so the objective conditions for radical change will be present for better or for worse the outcome will depend on us the subjective forces

this book examines a rapidly emerging new topic in urban settlement patterns the role of shrinking cities much coverage is given to declining fertility rates ageing populations and economic restructuring as the factors behind shrinking cities but there is also reference to resource depletion the demise of single company towns and the micro location of environmental hazards the contributions show that shrinkage can occur at any scale from neighbourhood to macro region and they consider whether shrinkage of metropolitan areas as a whole may be a future trend also addressed in this volume is the question of whether urban shrinkage policies are necessary or effective the book comprises four parts world or regional issues with reference to the european union and latin america national case studies the united states india china korea taiwan germany romania and estonia city case studies detroit buffalo cleveland naples belfast and halle and broad issues such as the environmental consequences of shrinking cities this book will be of interest to scholars and practitioners working in the fields of urban studies economic geography and public policy

This difference highlights the importance of understanding the specific system being used.
