this is the first etymological dictionary of proto celtic to be published after a hundred years synthesizing the work of several generations of celtic scholars it contains a reconstructed lexicon of proto celtic with ca 1500 entries the principal lemmata are alphabetically arranged words reconstructed for proto celtic each lemma contains the reflexes of the proto celtic words in the individual celtic languages the proto indo european pie roots from which they developed as well as the cognate forms from other indo european languages the focus is on the development of forms from pie to proto celtic but histories of individual words are explained in detail and each lemma is accompanied by an extensive bibliography the introduction contains an overview of the phonological developments from pie to proto celtic and the volume includes an appendix treating the probable loanwords from unknown non ie substrates in proto celtic

this volume offers a discussion of the phonological and morphological development of old irish and its indo european origins the emphasis is on the relative chronology of sound changes and on the development of the verbal system special attention is devoted to the origin of absolute and relative verb forms to the rise of the mutations to the role of thematic and athematic inflexion types in the formation of present classes preterits subjunctives and futures and to the development of deponents and passive forms other topics include infixes and suffixed pronouns palatalization of consonants and labialization of vowels

and the role of continental celtic in the reconstruction of proto celtic the final chapter provides a detailed analysis of the latin and other italic data which are essential to a reconstruction of proto italo celtic the appendix contains a full reconstruction of the old irish verbal paradigms which renders the subject more easily accessible to a wider audience the book is of interest to celticists latinists indo europeanists and other historical linguists

this book introduces proto indo european and explores what the language reveals about the people who spoke it the proto indo europeans lived somewhere in europe or asia between 5 500 and 8 000 years ago and no text of their language survives j p mallory and douglas adams show how over the last two centuries scholars have reconstructed it from its descendant languages the surviving examples of which comprise the world s largest language family after a concise account of proto indo european grammar and a consideration of its discovery they use the reconstructed language and related evidence from archaeology and natural history to examine the lives thoughts passions culture society economy history and environment of the proto indo europeans our distant ancestors had used the wheel were settled arable farmers kept sheep and cattle brewed beer got married made weapons and had 27 verbs for the expression of strife the subjects to which the authors devote chapters include fauna flora family and kinship clothing and textiles food and drink space and time emotions mythology religion and the continuing quest to discover the proto indo european homeland proto indo european english and english proto indo european vocabularies and full indexes conclude the book written in a clear readable style and illustrated with maps figures and tables this book is on a subject of great and enduring fascination it will appeal to students of languages classics and the ancient world as well as to general readers interested in the history of language and of early human societies

the celtic languages and groups called keltoi i e celts emerge into our written records at the pre roman iron age the impetus for this book is to explore from the perspectives of three disciplines archaeology genetics and linguistics the background in later european prehistory to these developments there is a traditional scenario according to which celtic speech and the associated group identity came in to being during the early iron age in the north alpine zone and then rapidly spread across central and western europe this idea of celtogenesis remains deeply entrenched in scholarly and popular thought but it has become increasingly difficult to reconcile with recent discoveries pointing towards origins in the deeper past it should no longer be taken for granted that atlantic europe during the 2nd and 3rd millennia bc were pre celtic or even pre indo european the explorations in celtic from the west 3 are drawn together in this spirit continuing two earlier volumes in the influential series

germania semitica explores prehistoric language contact in general and attempts to identify the languages involved in shaping germanic in particular the book deals with a topic outside the scope of other disciplines concerned with prehistory such as archaeology and genetics drawing its conclusions from the linguistic evidence alone relying on language typology and areal probability the data for reconstruction comes from germanic syntax phonology etymology religious loan names and the writing system more precisely from word order syntactic constructions word formation irregularities in phonological form lexical peculiarities and the structure and rules of the germanic runic alphabet it is demonstrated that common descent is neither a necessary nor a sufficient condition for reconstruction instead lexical and structural parallels between germanic and semitic languages are explored and interpreted in the framework of modern language contact theory

in the reflexes of the proto indo european laryngeals in celtic nicholas zair for the first time collects all the words from the celtic languages which contained a laryngeal and identifies the regular results of the laryngeals in each phonetic environment

this outline is followed by a structural sketch of the most important language or languages of the branch e.g. old Irish for Celtic Sanskrit and Avestan for Indo-Iranian Latin and Oscan-Umbrian for Italic the sketch also contains the phonology morphology and syntax of each language there is lastly a sample text of each language containing both interlinear and free translation in those branches where there are special issues e.g. the relation of Italic to Celtic and Baltic to Slavic or the problem of archaism in Hittite additional discussions of these issues are provided Baldi's final chapter gives a brief outline of the minor Indo-European languages such as Illyrian Thracian Raetic and Phrygian adding further to the usefulness of the book are extensive bibliographies an up-to-date map showing the geographical distribution of the Indo-European languages throughout the world and a detailed family tree diagram of the members of each subgroup within the Indo-European language family and their interrelationships

beyond the Aegean some of the earliest written records of Europe come from the south-west what is now southern Portugal and south-west Spain Herodotus the father of history locates the Keltoi or Celts in this region as neighbours of the Kunetes of the Algarve he calls the latter the westernmost people of Europe however modern scholars have been disinclined until recently to consider the possibility that the south-western inscriptions and other early linguistic evidence from the kingdom of Tartessos were Celtic this book shows how much of this material closely resembles the attested Celtic languages Celtiberian spoken in east-central Spain and Gaulish as well as the longer surviving languages of Ireland Britain and Brittany in many cases the 85 Tartessian inscriptions of the period c. 750 c. 450 BC can now be read as complete statements written in an ancient Celtic language
