this volume contends that young individuals across europe relate to their country s history in complex and often ambivalent ways it pays attention to how both formal education and broader culture communicate ideas about the past and how young people respond to these ideas the studies collected in this volume show that such ideas about the past are central to the formation of the group identities of nations social movements or religious groups young people express received historical narratives in new potentially subversive ways as young people tend to be more mobile and ready to interrogate their own roots than later generations they selectively privilege certain aspects of their identification with their family or nation while neglecting others this collection aims to correct the popular misperception that young
