folk memory can't touch such places may have played important roles in human evolution but can only be reconstructed through careful geological detective work exploring how lands become submerged whether from sea level changes tectonic changes gravity collapse giant waves or volcanoes helps us determine why when and where land may disappear in the future and what might be done to prevent it
