my mother s body marge piercy s tenth book of poetry takes its title from one of her strongest and most moving poems the climax of a powerful sequence of poems to her mother rooted in an honest harrowing but ally ecstatic confrontation of the mother daughter relationship in

all its complexity and intimacy it is at the same time an affirmation of continuity and identification the chuppah comprises poems actually used in her wedding ceremony with ira wood this section sings with powerfully female love poetry there is also a sustained and direct use of her jewish identity and faith in these poems as there is in a number of other poems throughout the volume readers of piercy s previous collections will not be surprised to encounter her mixture of the personal and the political her love of animals and the cape landscape there are poems about doing housework about accidents about dreaming about bag ladies about luggage about children s fears of nuclear holocaust about tomcats insects in the rafters the influence of a name appleblossoms and blackberries pollution and some of the ways women objectify one another in does the light fail us or do we fail the light piercy writes with lacerating honesty about our relationships with the elderly and about hers with her father some of the most moving poems are domestic as in the final sequence six underrated pleasures which finds in daily women s tasks both pleasure and mystery affirmation of self and connection with the mother in all my mother s body is one of piercy s most powerful and balanced collections

this new approach to the history of motherhood examines the role the female body played in defining motherhood from the mid eighteenth century through the first half of the nineteenth century demonstrating that physical representations or perceptions of the body were crucial to defining motherhood in different ways both for mothers themselves and for american culture at large

this book emphasizes the importance of communication and early attachment for babies acknowledging the value of both mother and father being there for their baby during pregnancy and after birth with quality time to acknowledge respect and enjoy the presence of their baby

pulitzer prize winner suzan lori parks s wildly original debut novel getting mother s body follows pregnant unmarried billy beede and her down and out family in 1960s texas as they search for the storied jewels buried or were they with billy s fast running six years dead mother willa mae getting mother s body is a true spiritual successor to the work of writers such as zora neale hurston and alice walker but when it comes to bringing hard luck characters to ingenious uproarious life suzan lori parks shares the stage with no one

in the second half of the eighteenth century motherhood came to be viewed as women s most important social role and the figure of the good mother was celebrated as a moral force in american society nora doyle shows that depictions of motherhood in american culture began to define the ideal mother by her emotional and spiritual roles rather than by her physical work as a mother as a result of this new vision lower class women and non white women came to be excluded from the identity of the good mother because american culture defined them in terms of their physical labor however doyle also shows that childbearing women contradicted the ideal of the disembodied mother in their personal accounts and instead perceived motherhood as fundamentally defined by the work of their bodies enslaved women were keenly aware that their reproductive bodies carried a literal price while middle class and elite white women dwelled on the physical sensations of childbearing and childrearing thus motherhood in this period was marked by tension between the lived experience of the maternal body and the increasingly

ethereal vision of the ideal mother that permeated american print culture

according to kelso the book of chronicles silences women in specific ways most radically through their association with maternity drawing on the work of two feminist philosophers luce irigaray and michelle boulous walker she argues that we may discern two principal strategies of silencing women in chronicles disavowal and repression of the maternal body in its simplest form the silencing of women takes place through both an explicit and implicit strategy of excluding them from the central action largely banished from the central action they are hardly able to contribute to the production of israel s past on a more complex level however women are most effectively silenced through their association with maternity because the maternal body is both disavowed and repressed in chronicles the association of women with maternity along with the disavowal and repression of the maternal body as origin of the masculine subject effects and guarantees the silence of the feminine enabling man to imagine himself as sole producer of his world these strategies of silencing the feminine need to be understood in relation to the relative absence of women from the narrative world of chronicles kelso argues that chronicles depends on the absence and silence of women for its imaginary coherence this argument is enabled by irigarayan theory but more importantly kelso suggests that irigaray also offers us a viable mode not method of reading writing listening and speaking as woman whatever that might mean in relation to the so called origins of western culture specifically the hebrew bible or old testament she argues that irigaray enables a not only rigorous feminist critique of patriarchy and its many texts but also somewhat more charitably a mode of reading that enables women to read the past differently seeking out what remains to be discovered especially the forgotten future in the past

this book examines a selection of texts to discuss how midwifery obstetrics and women s bodies were constructed during the long eighteenth century and how these material discursive entanglements between science medicine literature and culture have shaped society s views of pregnancy childbirth and reproduction drawing on theories from disciplines such as feminist new materialism this book traces the history of both the reproductive body and the pluralistic medical knowledges that attended to pregnancy and childbirth during the enlightenment and early romanticism in britain it identifies the significance of literary and cultural artefacts in this knowledge formation including the materiality of the female reproductive body itself and raises awareness of myths about pregnancy and childbirth that persist today this book features chapters exploring jonathan swift s gulliver s travels john cleland s fanny hill laurence sterne s tristram shandy eliza fenwick s secresy or the ruin on the rock mary wollstonecraft s maria or the wrongs of woman and mary shelley s frankenstein reproduction and the maternal body in literature and culture is an innovative and interdisciplinary contribution to the medical humanities and feminist philosophy of science and will interest scholars from a range of backgrounds including literature and cultural studies midwifery medicine and history

in this book alison stone develops a feminist approach to maternal subjectivity stone argues that in the west the self has often been understood in opposition to the maternal body so that one must separate oneself from the mother and maternal care givers on whom one depended in childhood to become a self or in modernity an autonomous subject these assumptions make it difficult to be a mother and a subject an autonomous creator of meaning insofar as mothers nonetheless strive to regain their subjectivity when their motherhood seems to have compromised it theirs cannot be the usual kind of subjectivity premised on separation from the maternal body mothers are subjects of a new kind who generate meanings and acquire agency from their position of re immersion in the realm of maternal body relations of bodily intimacy and dependency thus stone interprets maternal subjectivity as a specific form of subjectivity that is continuous with the maternal body stone analyzes this form of subjectivity in terms of how the mother typically reproduces with her child her history of bodily relations with her own mother leading to a distinctive maternal and cyclical form of lived time
