an accessible and empirically rich introduction to Canada's engagements in the world since confederation this introductory textbook charts a unique path by locating Canada's colonial foundations at the heart of the analysis Canada in the world begins by arguing that the colonial relations with indigenous peoples represent the first example of foreign policy and demonstrates how these relations became a foundational and existential element of the new state colonialism the project to establish settler capitalism in North America and the ideological assumption that Europeans were more advanced and thus deserved to conquer the indigenous people says Shipley lives at the very heart of Canada through a close examination of Canadian foreign policy from crushing an indigenous rebellion in El Salvador peacekeeping missions in the Congo and Somalia and Cold War interventions in Vietnam and Indonesia to Canadian participation in

the war on terror canada in the world finds that this colonial heart has dictated canada's actions in the world since the beginning highlighting the continuities across more than 150 years of history shipley demonstrates that canadian policy and behaviour in the world is deep rooted and argues that changing this requires rethinking the fundamental nature of canada itself

this third edition of dennis guest s book provides the most complete and up to date history of social welfare in this country yet it also

offers insights into the nuts and bolts of policy creation and explodes recent myths that underlie the current residual approach to social policy such as death by deficit and the inevitable demise of the Canada Pension Plan. The emergence of social security in Canada is both an important historical resource and an engrossing tale in its own right and it will be of great interest to anyone concerned about Canadian social policy.

Canadian historians have always looked favourably on MacDonald's national policies including the protective tariff. On the other hand, the canons of economic theory have little or nothing to say in favour of protection. Professor Dales attempts in these essays to bridge this gap between trade theory and the standard interpretation of Canadian development. In the first three essays he is concerned with relaxing the rigorous assumptions of labour and capital immobility that characterize theoretical writings on international trade in order to make them more applicable to Canada. For it must be recognized that large movements of labour and capital both into and out of the country have been one of the most important features of the Canadian economy. Today the next three chapters discuss the probable historical effects of Canadian protection in the light of the modified theory. Professor Dales makes statistical comparisons between the economic development of Canada and the United States in order to identify the main differences between the patterns of economic growth in the two countries and to throw light on the large and persistent gap between the Canadian and American standards of living. The last two essays are in the nature of provocative squibs designed to break up some of the hard-core conventional wisdom about the Canadian economy. Although free trade versus protection has long been a dormant issue in policy discussions, it never quite disappears from the scene. Professor Dales persists in thinking that free trade with all countries and unilaterally, if necessary, is the best policy for Canada. The controversial issues raised by these essays are of the highest importance not only to historians and economists but to all in any way concerned with the public policies of this country. The book focuses our attention on a basic antinomy of Canadian life and thought that has been little recognized and by its stimulating analysis will help to form the shape of our continuing nation.

Agnew delves into the public and private spheres of several distinct communities in order to expose the underlying inequalities within Canada's economic, social, legal and political systems that frequently

result in the denial of basic rights to migrant women

this text focuses on the shared pacific west political arena of washington state and the province of british columbia but has many implications for comparison drawn at the national level using multiple methodologies the book reports the results of investigative differences in the two countries including political cultures and public preferences in three major areas of public policy native claims immigration and forest resource management

potential of indigenous economies in canada

this collection examines historical and contemporary social economic and environmental impacts of mining on aboriginal communities in northern canada combining oral history research with intensive archival study this work juxtaposes the perspectives of government and industry with the perspectives of local communities

in response to concerns that the educational system from public schools through colleges universities and apprenticeship programs cannot adequately prepare students for work in the new economy integrating school and workplace learning in canada proposes alternation a hybrid form of learning that by combining experiential and cognitive learning skills allows individuals to develop the relevant skills and intellectual capabilities to address and solve complex problems encountered in the workplace alternation involves not only a curricular balance between the theoretical and the practical but also two distinct venues for learning the classroom and the workplace the authors discuss cognitive and social learning its implementation in a variety of settings its role in smoothing the school work transition process and its potential to contribute to the knowledge and skills needed by the workforce they bring a wide range of disciplinary perspectives to bear in their analyses of the principles and practices of alternation providing historical theoretical and practical insights their analysis contributes to and extends the current debate and discussion surrounding necessary changes in our education and training practices

from the mid nineteenth century onward advocates argued that technology as a moral force would strengthen the ties that bound canada to britain and western civilization while opponents saw technology as a source of american power that threatened canadian independence the technological imperative in canada offers new insights into the ideas of influential and lesser known theorists of technology and morality that will appeal to anyone who wants a canadian perspective on a critical subject
